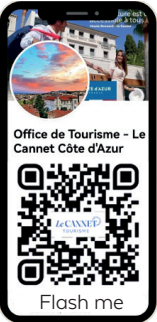

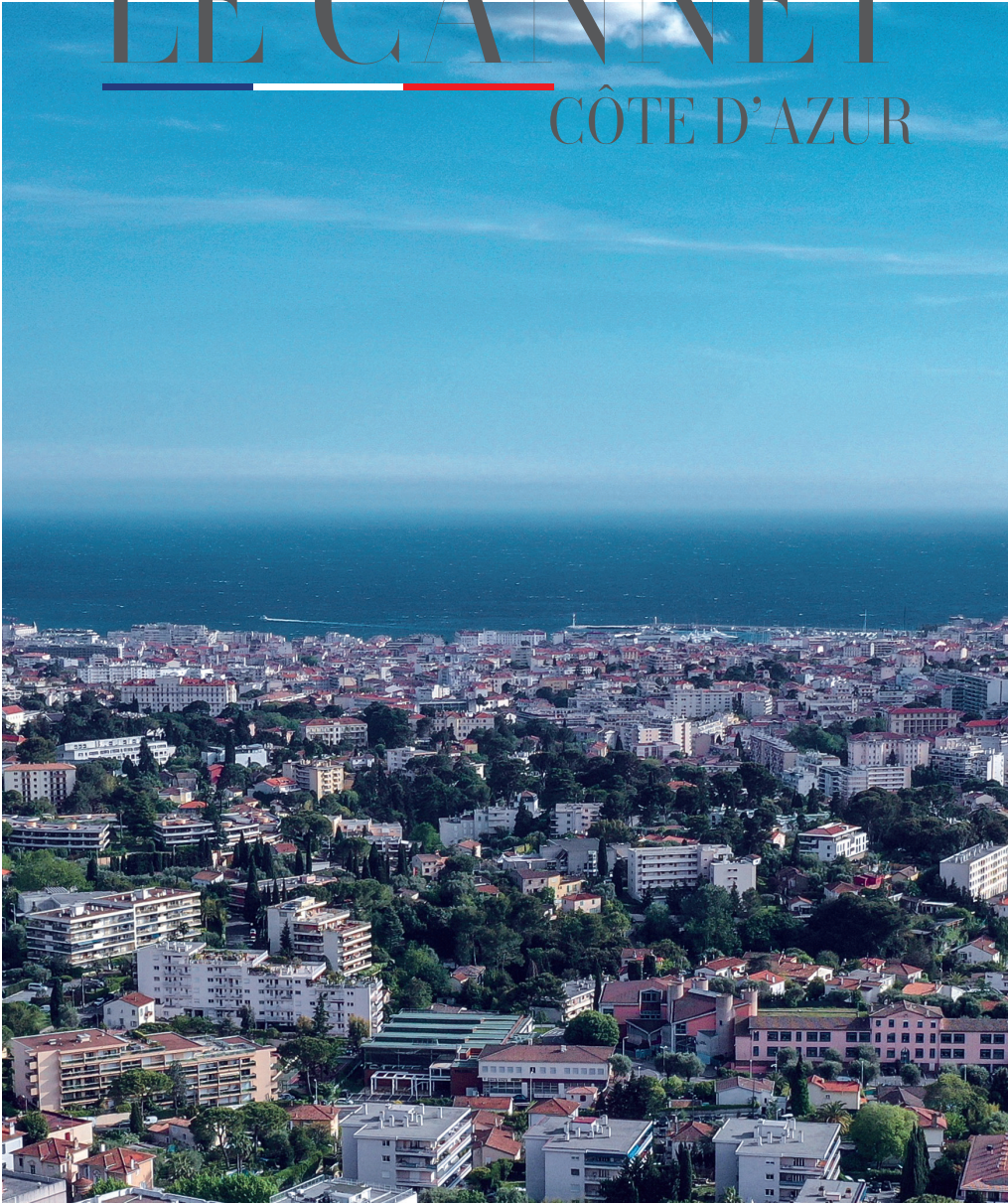

Its south-facing light and exceptional landscapes have attracted many artists, including Pierre Bonnard, whose unique and dedicate museum shines in Le Cannet.



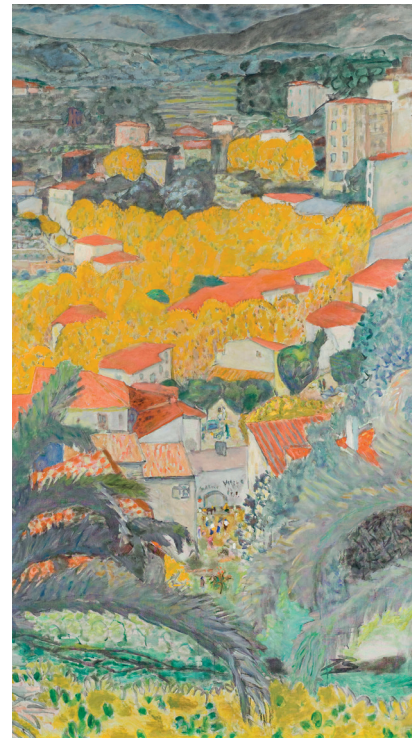
The Bonnard Museum
