


























Succumb to the charm and relaxed lifestyle of Le Cannet Côte d'Azur, a veritable terrace overlooking the Mediterranean Sea!

Its south-facing light and exceptional landscapes have attracted many artists, including Pierre Bonnard, whose unique and dedicate museum shines in Le Cannet.


The Bonnard Museum

The Musée Bonnard, which was awarded the «Musée de France» label in 2006, is a natural fit with the town of Le Cannet, which inspired Pierre Bonnard with its landscapes and the light of the French riviera. He lived here for his last 27 years, painting some of his finest masterpieces.

According to a calendar that can be consulted on its website*, in addition to the presentation of its collections, the museum offers temporary exhibitions on subjects that are always linked to Pierre Bonnard, and that are popular with both national and international audiences. Throughout the year, the museum's outreach team also offers cultural activities tailored to each audience, such as educational workshops and guided tours.
